Whereas, this Order is adopted in accordance with Local Government Code Sect 240 002, as amended,

Whereas, this Order applies in the unincorporated areas of Leon County,


Whereas, the Court finds that certain non-domestic animals pose a danger both to the residents and to the domestic animals in Leon County,


It is hereby ordered by the Commissioners Court of Leon County that the keeping of the following wild animals is prohibited in Leon County


Lions, tigers, ocelots, cougars, leopards, cheetah, jaguars, bobcats, lynx, servals, caracals, hyenas, bears, coyotes, jackals, baboons, chimpanzees, orangutans, gorillas, wolves, and hybrids of these animals


A person who harbors or keeps in Leon County, Texas an animal prohibited by this Order commits an offense An offense or violation of this Order is a Class "C" misdemeanor The County Attorney or another attorney representing the County shall prosecute such violations, and may file an action to enjoin a violation or a threatened violation of the Order
